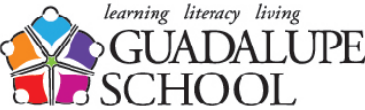

TRANSITIONING TO REMOTE LEARNING

In March 2020, we transitioned to remote learning. The adjustment was not easy. Preschool teacher Ms. Goldhardt expressed that she has "been amazed to see the innovation and development of new ideas on how to keep our class unified during this pandemic." While our front desk staff checked out laptops to students, our creative teachers utilized a range of platforms from Google

Classroom to Zoom in order to continue education remotely. Our Adult Education team recorded lessons and created an interactive blog to keep students engaged at their skill level. Teachers across all of our programs called, texted, emailed, and video chatted with families regularly to keep students engaged. Everyone at Guadalupe came together as a team to support our families and continue to provide high quality education.



NO MEAL LEFT UNSERVED

On a typical day at Guadalupe, you will see our kitchen team cranking out breakfast, lunch, and snacks and serving them to a bustling lunchroom. When COVID-19 hit and we transitioned to remote learning, the cooking never stopped. March through June, we provided nearly 51,000 meals. Every day, our kitchen team prepared breakfast, lunch, and a snack for our students which was then bussed to their homes or made available at our front office for pick up. Not even a 5.7 magnitude earthquake could stop our team from feeding our students!



GRADUATION PARADES ARE ALL THE RAGE

"The world changed, and Guadalupe changed with it," said our Charter School Principal Katina Santamaria as her faculty and staff decorated the school parking lot for a less than traditional 6th grade graduation ceremony on Wednesday, June 3rd. Graduating from the 6th grade continues to be an important accomplishment for our students and one that merits great

celebration. This year's ceremony looked a bit different that last. Instead of walking up to a podium in front of a gymnasium packed full of proud families, students drove through in a car parade, were sung to, and received graduation certificates and fun gifts to make entry to middle school easier.
